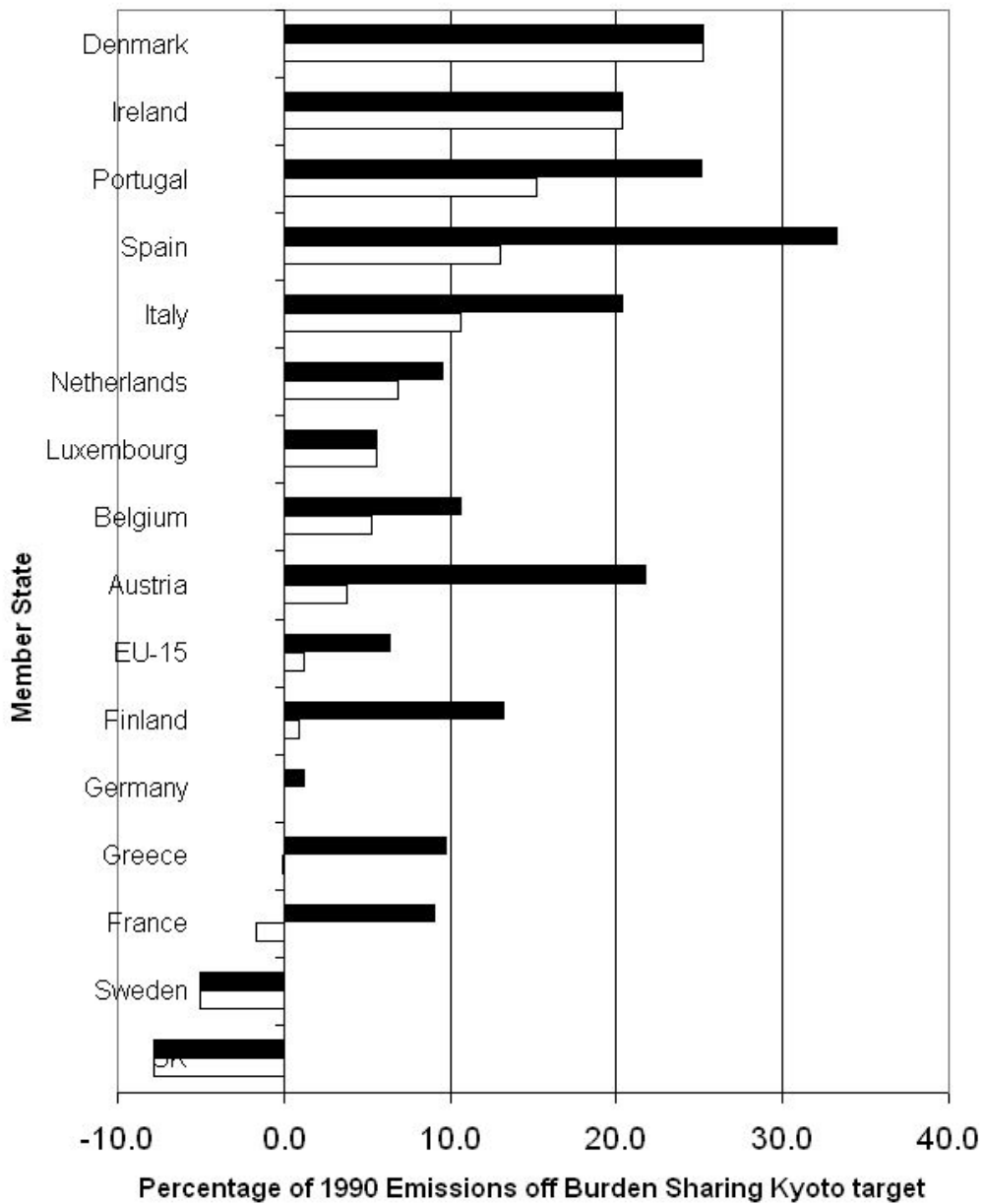


Projected deviation from Kyoto target for each of the 15 countries in the EU burden sharing agreement
